Dear Colleague:

On March 28, 2019, following legislation, the President of the United States signed Executive Order 13866, which adjusted the General Schedule rates of basic pay. Because the financial disclosure threshold is based on the General Schedule, the adjustment increased the threshold for financial disclosure filing. **The new financial disclosure salary threshold for calendar year 2019 is \$127,914.**

This change applies retroactively to the beginning of the calendar year. The original threshold for calendar year 2019 was \$126,148. This was based on Executive Order 13856, signed on December 28, 2018, which provided that the General Schedule rates of basic pay would remain unchanged in 2019. However, that order was superseded by Executive Order 13866.
